

IHSDP : The basic objective of Integrated Housing and Slum Development programme is the holistic slum development with a healthy and enabling urban environment by providing adequate shelter and basic infrastructure facilities to the slum dwellers who do not possess adequate shelter and reside in dilapidated conditions as identified by ULB. The scheme will cover to all cities / towns, excepting cities / towns included under JNNURM.

The components of the scheme will include all slum improvement / upgradation/relocation projects including upgradation/new construction of houses and infrastructure facilities as mention below :
