

## Municipal Solid Waste Management Scheme for 10 municipal Towns in Kolkata Metropolitan Area

<b>Objective</b>	To create / introduce an efficient Solid Waste Management system in ten ULBs (as stated below) within KMA in compliance with MSW Rules 2000, by shifting from unscientific dumping to integrated Solid Waste Management
<b>Area Covered</b>	Ten municipal towns in Kolkata Urban Agglomeration viz. Garulia, North Barrackpore, Barrackpore, Budge Budge, Bansberia, Hooghly Chinsurah, Kamarhati, Rajarhat-Gopalpur, Rajpur-Sonarpur and Bally.
