Objective	To create / introduce an efficient Solid Waste Management system in ten ULBs (as stated below) within KMA in compliance with MSW Rules 2000.
Area covered	Ten municipal towns viz. Garulia, North Barrackpore, Barrackpore, Budge Budge, Bansberia, Hooghly-Chinsurah, Kamarhati, Rajarhat-Gopalpur, Rajpur-Sonarpur and Bally.
