Undertaking/Autonomous Bodies/Semi-Govt./Statutory Bodies/Local Bodies, having credentials i.e., completion certificate of executing at least 50% (1/2) value of similar nature of work in a single contract within last 5 (five) years from the date of issue of this N.I.T. are eligible to apply for the work stated below :

North Circle, SD & SWM Sector, KMDA.

The tender papers are not transferable and the cost of the tender papers is not adjustable / refundable under any circumstances.

Tender papers will be issued by the Executive Engineer, East bank Division, SD & SWM Sector, KMDA whose office is located at Unnyan Bhavan, Block – A, 5th floor, Salt Lake, Kol – 91.to the tenderers who have applied for purchase of tender paper along with a Demand Draft / Pay Order of Rs. 2,000/- per set to the Superintending Engr. North Circle, SD & SWM Sector, KMDA.

The tender papers are not transferable and the cost of the tender papers are not adjustable / refundable under any circumstances.

Tender papers are to be submitted in two parts viz. Part – I and Part – II in two separate sealed covers and both these parts are to be put in a single outer sealed cover and is to be submitted in a single part as per stipulations given hereinabove.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF TENDERERS FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE TENDER

1. Tenderers must have credentials in execution and satisfactory completion of similar nature of completion cost not less than 50% of the value of work under present tender in a single contract under any Govt. / Semi-Govt. Organisation / Autonomous body./Statutory Bodies/Local Bodies as principal employer within the last 5 (five) years.
2. Joint Ventures/Consortium must comply with the following requirements :

- I) In case the application is from a consortium of a bidder, then initial application for purchase of Tender Papers is to be submitted in a plain paper with signature of all the members of consortium and respective official seal.
- II) In case the bid is from a consortium of bidders, one of the partners in the consortium has to be designated as lead partner and the same is mentioned in MoA/MoU
- II) Any bid from a consortium shall be accompanied by a copy of the MoA/MoU on a Rs.100=00 stamp paper outlining the joint interest to work on the project and specifying the other terms of agreement.
- III) The lead partner must hold at least 51% equity capital of the company to be formed between them during the tenure of contract implementation.
- IV) The successful consortium of bidders will have to form a special purpose vehicle (S.P.V.) and register the same under the Indian Company's Act.
- V) The Lead Partner must have credential and satisfactory completion of similar nature of works of completion cost not less than 50% of the value of qualifying amount i.e. 50% of the value of work under present tender in a single contract under any Govt. / Semi-Govt. Organisation / Autonomous body Statutory Bodies/Local Bodies as principal employer within the last 5 (five) years.
- VI) Each of the other partners shall meet individually not less than 25% of the qualifying criteria mentioned above, under any Govt. / Semi-Govt. Organisation / Autonomous body /Statutory Bodies/Local Bodies as principal employer within the last 5 (five) years. However, the Lead Partner along with other partner/partners should jointly meet at least 100% of the qualifying criteria.
- VII) In case the application is from a consortium of a bidder, then the documents as mentioned under the head of "DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED IN 'SEALED COVER' MARKED PART - I" will have to be submitted in respect of each of the members of the consortium.
- VIII) In case of any litigation or in the event of any default arises during the execution/contract period of the agreement, the lead partner will remain fully responsible.
- IX) The successful consortium of bidders will have to submit Vat Registration, Pan Card, and Trade License etc. after getting letter of intent (LOI) of the work.

DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED IN 'SEALD COVER' MARKED PART - I

1. Photo-copies of credentials letter of Intent, Work Order and other documents including payment certificate relating to similar nature of work completed by the agency (as per eligibility criteria referred above).
2. Photo copies of VAT Registration and latest clearance certificate.

3. Photo copies of Income Tax Return for the last 3 (three) financial years. alongwith earnest money in Demand Draft.
4. Copies of PAN Card in the name of Firm issued by the Income Tax Authority.
5. Latest Professional Tax Clearance Certificates.
6. Documents relating to financial capability of the tenderers
7. Last three financial years Audited Reports
8. Partners Firm should submit a copy of the Partnership Deed along with the Part-I of the Tender Documents otherwise the Tender may not be considered.

Note :- All the above documents should be duly attested and bear "Submitted by me" with signature and official seal of the agency.

The original documents as stated above must also be produced for verification when called for by the KMDA, after opening of the Technical Bid Part – I of the tender, failing which the tender will not be accepted.

Tenderers who fail to submit all the above mentioned documents, will not be qualified for participating in the (Price Bid), Part – II of the tender.

DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED IN 'SEALED COVER' MARKED PART - II (FINANCIAL BID)

1. The original tender documents duly signed by the tenderer, alongwith their office seal, of the bottom of each page of the tender documents and the printend tender form the tenderer is to quote in figures as well as in words. His rates in the specified space in Page-2 of KMDA Printed From No. 1.

Further Mandatory terms and conditions of the tender

1. The tenderer must submit in 'Technical Bid' Part-1 of the tender a written declaration in the from of an Affidavit before Notary as to be correctness of the copies of all the documents submitted by him, and a declaration of any penalty/debartment etc. faced by him under any Govt. /Semi-Govt./Autonomous body etc.
2. The successful tenderers shall deposit 2% of the tendered amount less the initial earnest money in the from of Demand Draft/Pay Order/NSC (Pledged)/F.D. of any Nationalized Bank in favour of SD &SWM Sector, KMDA during execution of formal agreement with KMDA as initial Security deposit.
3. Security deposit (including the initial security deposit) @ 10% (ten percent) of the gross bill value will be deducted from each and every running bill & the final bill without any upper calling limit.
4. In case of reserved work, the registered un-employed Engineer's Co-operative Societies will be exempted from depositing initial earnest money along with their tenders, but the security deposit @ 10% will be deducted from the progressive bill during execution of work.
5. 1% (one percent) cess of the cost of the construction will be deducted from the contractor's Bills under Section 7 (seven) of the Building and other construction workers (RECS) Act, 1996 and Building and other construction workers welfare cess Act, 1996 and the Rules frame thereunder.
6. The tender may also be received by Registered Post with A.D. only at the option of the tenderer, so as to reach this office of the tendering authority within the stipulated date and time. The tendering authority will not be responsible for any delay/loss/non-receipt of tender documents sent by Registered Post.
7. If any documents furnished by the tender are found to be false, incorrect and misleading even after opening of the tenders, the tender will be declared Informal.


